Technology Transfer Training Program

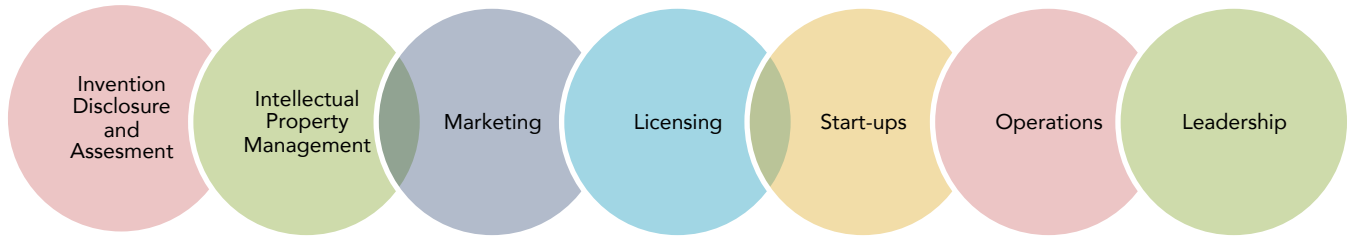

Technology Transfer Fundamentals

The large number of webinars available make it possible to do specialized training in specific subareas, such as software licensing, plant variety licensing, life science licensing, new company formation and others. Additionally, at regular intervals, fellows communicate with an assigned mentor who help guide and advise them on personal career goals.



Knowledge gained through webinar participation is reiterated in the classroom at the Essentials of Tech Transfer course and is further enhanced by the formation of a peer networking group.
